

Call for Proposals

"One year projects in three areas of energy storage"

Energy SUPERSTORE: Call for Research Proposals – The SUPERGEN Energy Storage Hub (Energy SUPERSTORE), funded by the Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council (EPSRC), invites proposals from the UK research community in the following areas:

1. Integration of energy storage into the electricity system

2. Electrochemical Energy Storage

This topic excludes redox flow as the SUPERSTORE is supporting this through the recent CAM-IES/Superstore RFB project call: https://www.energy.cam.ac.uk/cam-ies/rfb-call

3. Non-electrochemical Energy Storage

Up to 2 proposals will be funded in each of the 3 areas.

Funding will be up to £100,000 per proposal (£100k = 80% Research Council FEC). Each grant will run for 1 year. Proposals will be subject to peer review by members of the Hub's Science Board (drawn from the UK research community). The final award of the proposals will be the decision of the Energy Storage Hub Management and Advisory Boards. The timeline is given in the table below.

Proposals should be submitted using the form that may be downloaded from this link <u>Application</u> <u>form</u>. The Case for Support should be no more than four A4 pages in length, no smaller than 11 pt Calibri, single spacing and margins of at least 2 cm, and must include the following:

- a track record of the academics (1/2 page);
- a statement of why the work is important to advancing the energy storage field;
- a description of the work to be undertaken and the research methodology;
- a clear indication of the expected impact of the work and how this will be achieved, including a work plan;
- 1 page containing the budget and a justification of resources.



Proposals should be submitted by email to <u>Mrs Zsofia Lazar</u> (full contact details below) by **5pm on Tuesday 20 February 2018**. Letters of support from project partners should be attached and do not count towards the page limit.
